

Last month, the ARTARx pharmacy announced preferential pricing on Freestyle Libre and Freestyle Libre 2 sensors purchased through the pharmacy. This pricing is available to anyone who visits the pharmacy, whether they are ARTARx Benefit Plan members or not. It is important to note, ARTA Benefit Plan coverage for Freestyle Libre, Freestyle Libre 2, and other flash or continuous glucose sensors remains the same. Only those members who actively use insulin at the time of purchase are eligible for sensor coverage. As well, all claims are still subject to diabetes supplies maximums.

The only thing that has changed is the price of the sensors when purchased through the ARTA $\mathbf{R}\mathbf{x}$ pharmacy — now \$99.97 per sensor.
