

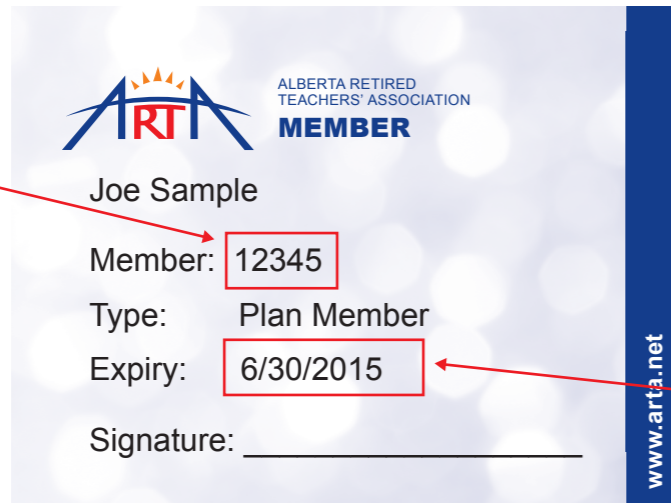
# Know Your Cards

## ARTA Membership Card

Your **ARTA Membership card** is used to:

- Access the member portal section of ARTA's website, [www.arta.net](http://www.arta.net), where you can:
  - Update your information, such as address, etc.
  - Access detailed information on Affinity Program partners and their special offers and discounts and ensure that you stay up to date on the additions of new partners
- Access to a Life Insurance Plan specifically for ARTA members
- Access to scholarships for family members
- Access to special rates from ARTA's home & auto insurance partner, TW Insurance Brokers
- Advocacy for issues affecting seniors in Alberta and nationally
- Affiliation to ARTA branches that provide localized community activities, networking opportunities and a conduit for effective communication to all ARTA members
- Access to wellness information

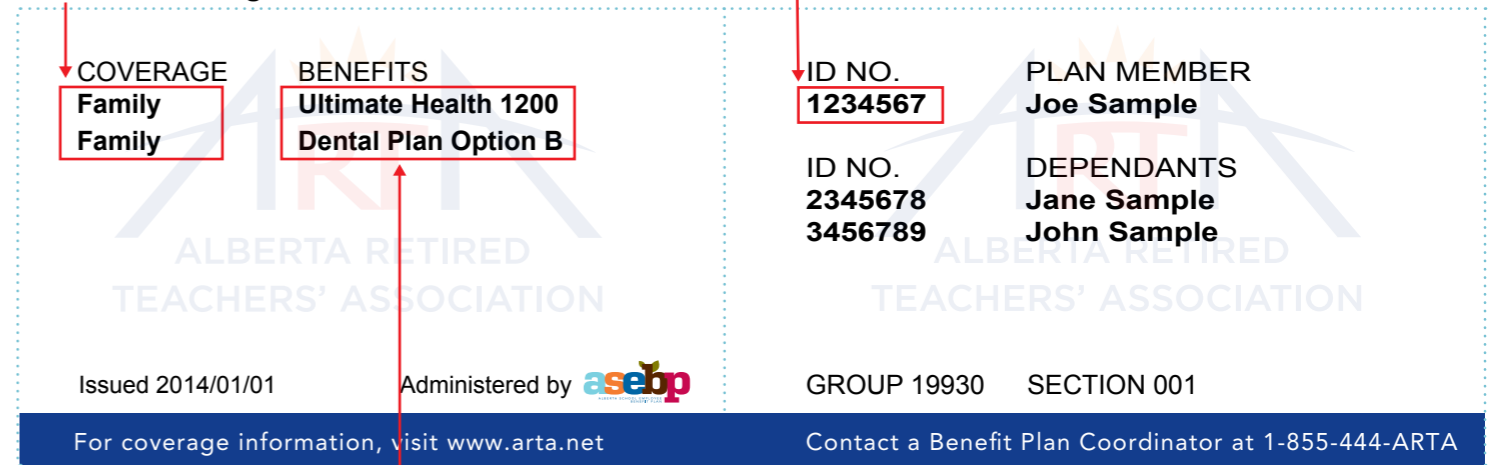
## ARTA Retiree Benefits ID Card

Your **ARTA Retiree Benefits ID card** is to be used for your Health, Dental and Travel Benefits.

- Provide your ARTA benefits numbers to health care professionals, e.g. dentist, pharmacist, etc.
- Use your ARTA Benefits ID number to log in to the ARTA Members Health Care Account, which can be found at <https://arta.asebp.ab.ca>.
- If your Extended Health Care coverage includes travel, bring this card on all trips. All emergency travel numbers are on the back of your card.
