The ARTA—TW INSURANCE SCHOLARSHIPS are made possible by the generosity of ARTA and TW Insurance Brokers, a service partner for home and auto insurance. ARTA and TW Insurance Brokers provides scholarships for undergraduate students who are related to an ARTA member.

These scholarships recognize academic achievement plus community involvement and volunteer work. Future goals, personal accomplishment, and supporting letters will also be significant in the overall determination of the scholarship recipients.

CRITERIA

1. The Scholarship Selection Committee will consider all valid applications. The committee's decision is final.
2. The value of the scholarship fund is dispersed as follows:
 - **\$5,000.00** (*up to two will be awarded*)
 - **\$3,000.00** (*up to two will be awarded*)
 - **\$2,000.00** (*up to two will be awarded*)
3. Applications are welcome from **direct relatives** (children, grandchildren, 1st and 2nd generation nieces and nephews) who are sponsored by current ARTA members.
4. The scholarships are limited to those applicants who have successfully completed at least one year of an **undergraduate or transfer program** leading to a first degree.
5. An official transcript from the post-secondary institutions must accompany the application. (Only official transcripts will be returned.)
6. Applicants must supply **only two letters of reference**. Contact information with the name, address, telephone number and email address of each reference must be included. The selection committee reserves the right to contact references.
7. The ARTA office must receive applications **no later than July 31** of the current year.
8. Scholarship applicants will be notified of the committee's **decision by September 15** of the current year.
9. Applicants who have **previously received** a Degree Scholarship or a Certificate/ Diploma Scholarship through ARTA **do not qualify** for a subsequent scholarship.
